


## FY2010 BUDGET CALENDAR




**June 1<sup>st</sup>** - Estimated Property Taxable Value Received from the Property Appraiser




**June 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, & 19<sup>th</sup>** - Board of County Commissioners workshops to consider development of Fiscal Year 2010 Budget

**July 1<sup>st</sup>** - Property Appraiser certifies on Form DR-420, to each taxing authority, the adjusted taxable value within the jurisdiction of each taxing authority.




**July 8<sup>th</sup>** - Board of County Commissioners adopts Resolution certifying tentative millage rates and resolution to advertise Non-Ad Valorem rates (within 15 days of receiving Tax Value Certification Form from the Property Appraiser).

**(By) August 4<sup>th</sup>** - Property Appraiser notified of proposed millage rolled-back rates and date and time of FY2010 Budget public hearings (within 35 days of Tax Value Certification).



**(By) August 24<sup>th</sup>** - Property Appraiser mails TRIM notices (within 55 days of Tax Value Certification).

**(By) August 25<sup>th</sup>** - Tax Collector mails Non-Ad Valorem notices to taxpayers (20 days prior to Non-Ad Valorem public hearing).



**(By) August 25<sup>th</sup>** - Ad for Non-Ad Valorem public hearing (20 days prior to Non-Ad Valorem public hearing).

**September 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>** - Board of County Commissioners workshops to consider Proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 Budget

**September 14<sup>th</sup>** - Budget Public Hearing @ Commission Chambers, County Administration Center, 1660 Ringling Boulevard, Sarasota – 7:00 P.M. First public hearing to adopt tentative countywide millage rate, section 1 and section 2 of the tentative budgets and tentative millage and budgets for districts and to adopt the Proposed FY2010 Financial Plan and final non-ad valorem assessments.

**September 28<sup>th</sup>** - Budget Public Hearing @ R.L Anderson Administration Center, 4000 S. Tamiami Trail, Venice – 7:00 P.M. Final public hearing to adopt final countywide millage rate, section 1 and section 2 of the budget and final millage and budgets for districts and final FY2010 Financial Plan. Adoption of FY2010 Capital Financial Plan (CIP) and FY2010-FY2014 CIP by Resolution, and adoption of Ordinance bringing CIP into consistency with the Comprehensive Plan. Adopt Ordinance and Resolution relating to the Infrastructure Surtax.

**October 1<sup>st</sup>** - Certification of adopted millage and Certification of FY2010 Financial Plan by Resolution to Tax Collector and Property Appraiser (within 3 days after adoption).

**October 29<sup>th</sup>** - Budget certified in compliance with Florida Statutes 200.065 and 200.068 to the Department of Revenue (within 30 days of adoption of budget).
